



About the Keep It 100% Luncheon

Future Foundation levels the playing field for at-risk youth in metro Atlanta through integrated, year-round case management, education, health, and life skills programs. Now in our 15th year, we connect over 1500 youth and their parents annually with the tools and supports to step up and out of poverty. We have achieved a *100% high school graduation rate and matriculation to college* among our teen participants since 2007, despite a 50% graduation rate average in our primary target areas.

For the past 10 years, Future Foundation has helped every teen in our comprehensive Afterschool program to envision a future, make a plan to achieve it, and matriculate to a 2- or 4-year college. That is a 100% high school graduation rate and matriculation to college, twice the rate of their peers. Our model builds a sense of belonging and purpose in youth, and our enrichment collaborative connects kids to the case management, health, education, and employment services they need to be successful. Our strategy, *Future Foundation 2.0*, transforms graduation rates for individual youth and, in partnership with Fulton County Schools, is beginning to transform graduation rates for entire low-performing high schools.

Our annual **Keep It 100% Luncheon** celebrates Atlanta’s past, present and future philanthropic investments in education for underserved youth. Led by honorary chair, **Curley M. Dossman, Jr., President Georgia-Pacific Foundation**; event hosts, **Imara Canady, AIDS Health Foundation** and **Lisa Robinson, Robinson Realty Group** and a committee of 25 influential Atlanta business and community leaders, the Keep It 100% Luncheon is our signature fundraising event.
